



Mongolian pastoral herders make up one of the world's last remaining nomadic cultures. For millennia, herders have lived on the Mongolian land and they still live in traditional felt tents, subsisting on the meat and milk of their animals, and living as free as the country is wide. The tents are called *gers*, and come in all sizes but one shape circular. Gers are held together without a single nail, they stand as monuments to a nomad's genius and self-sufficient way of life. Average size of nomadic family is 6-7 and they usually have 4-5 children. Mongolian women have always had a prominent position in Mongol society. Like the men, nomadic women have a well-defined role in the Mongolian nomad's way of life. Hospitality is what impresses visitors most about Mongolian people. To be a visitor in Mongolia is to be an honoured guest in the shared home of an entire people. Nomads devote their day tending to their livestock watching over, milking, shearing, or combing to produce felt and felt clothes, cheese and other milk dairy products. Mongolians are master horse riders. Many families own large herds of horses that roam the fenceless steppe, and fermented mare's milk, which the Mongolians call *airag*, is a popular drink. Traditionally, the nomads' skill on horseback has been essential for guarding their herds and driving them to pasture.

For this tour, you will stay separate ger neighbouring nomadic family and meals are prepared by our chef and served to you in your ger. You typically day will be experience in daily life of nomadic family and socialize with team as a family member and relax. We think it is a great tour which gives you a real insight into Mongolia. As always with us though, you can change any of this if you want. Make it longer or shorter it's up to you.

DAY 1. ULAANBAATAR

On arrival you will be met by our representative, and then be privately transferred to your hotel in Ulaanbaatar. In the afternoon, after a lunch, you will enjoy a leisurely time of sightseeing around UB and visit to the Gandan Monastery and the National History Museum where presents our history and culture from prehistoric to the present day. Early evening after sightseeing program, we invite you a welcome dinner at a restaurant.

Accommodation: Hotel. Meals: LD

DAY 2-4. ALTAN BULAG, TUV PROVINCE

Experience everyday life of nomads, early rising to try cow and sheep milking as a help with housewife, herd sheep on horseback, admiring beauty of nature, learn how to call vary age of sheep and goats and colour of them. For the lunch, help you make dumpling cooking and enjoy your first made Mongolian meal. And learn dairy food production. Yoghurt, dried curds etc., Learn cooking nomadic noodle soup.

Accommodation: Ger (Yurt). Meals: BLD

DAY 5. KHARKHORUM

We head out of the city early this morning to Kharkhorum via Hustai NP which serves as a breeding centre for Takhi re-introduction programmes throughout Mongolia and the Central Asian Steppe. Takhi is the world's last truly wild horse and is critically endangered. Early afternoon we will arrive in Kharakhorum and visit Erdenezuu Monastery. After it we will visit Karakhorum Museum. Overnight stay at Ger camp.

Accommodation: Ger Camp. Meals: BLD

DAY 6. TERELJ NATIONAL PARK

Morning check out from the Ger camp and we'll drive to Terelj National Park on the way we'll have a lunch at tourist camp near Elsen Tasarkhai sand dunes. Terelj National Park where you'll spend another night is located right in the middle of the Khentii Mountain Range. Settle into your room at a traditional Ger (yurt) tourist camp in Terelj. Early afternoon, we'll visit to a local nomadic family and experience traditional dairy products and horse ride (optional) to interesting natural rock formation named as a Turtle Rock. Family style dinner served in the evening.

Accommodation: Ger Camp. Meals: BLD: BLD

DAY 7. ULAANBAATAR

This morning you'll head to UB and on the way you'll visit the statue of Genghis Khan which is currently the biggest equestrian statue in the world. Here we may spend approx 2 hours after that toward to the capital city. After a lunch, you should also have time to visit the "Gobi" cashmere factory store and antique shop (optional). Before a farewell dinner, in the early evening, you'll attend traditional folk art performance.

Accommodation: Hotel. Meals: BLD

DAY 8. DEPARTURE

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airport for your onward flight and our service ends.

Holiday Status

You no longer need to worry about cancellations due to low numbers as most of our departures in Mongolia, whether joining shared services for excursions or completely going solo, are guaranteed to depart. Depending on its uniqueness, adventure holidays are usually sold all inclusive of accommodation, meals and activities described. The price you pay is usually a direct reflection on the level of service.

What the Price Includes

All of our holidays include the following services, as described in our itineraries: domestic flights (where appropriate), land transport, accommodation, meals, trip leaders and support staff and entrance fees to some national parks.

What the Price does not include

Visas, vaccinations, bar bills, extra drinks with meals, hotel refreshments, laundry, telephone calls, souvenirs, meals other than those specified in the relevant trip dossier.

Transport

All transports during the trip are included transfers as per the itinerary.

Accommodation

Besides offering well measured five star hotel in UB, we offer Ger camps which are the most common accommodation outside UB on our tours. Camping and stays in Ger camps are popular options, with some beautifully appointed stays in remote locations available for the adventurous. Accommodation in the Ger camp is two guests to share one Ger which is quite cozy well equipped with the key requirements being cleanliness, safety, comfort and a good location.

Family Rooming

We will room your family in the most appropriate way using a mixture of twin, triple, double and single rooms as necessary. We will leave it to you to decide who shares with whom in your family group.

Single Rooms

Most tours are based on customers sharing twin-bedded rooms. However, on many tours we offer the opportunity to pay a supplement to pre-book a single room.

Included Meals

All our tours include full board, but other meals are often not included especially in UB. This allows you to try the cuisine in local restaurants and also to choose what and where to eat and how much to spend. Please ask us before booking if you have any specific requirements.

Passports

A full passport is required for all of our holidays and this should be valid for at least six months after the completion of your trip. To secure your booking and avoid incurring additional charges, you must provide information on your booking form precisely as it is shown on your passport.

Visas

You may require a visa to enter Mongolia. Your consultant will be happy to advise you on visa requirements.

Booking


Only once you are completely happy with any holiday itinerary we create for you will we ask for a payment. In order that we can secure availability for your booking we would typically require a deposit of 15%.
